



## PROJECTS UPDATE

### NACIMIENTO CHURCH

This trench in the ground may not look like much, but it is! It is the beginning of the new church for the Guatemalan village of Nacimiento. This October, Neighbors First will be sending a team of nearly 20 men who have volunteered to help construct the new church building. 80% of the \$12,000 required to purchase the building materials has been generously donated. We are trusting God for the balance within the next few months.



### BILL'S HOUSE

A 100 year old farm house with an aging exterior was beyond the means or ability for Bill to repair. This June, NFI volunteers replaced sections of rotten siding, scraped, and painted Bill's home to bring it and Bill new HOPE.



### WILLIAM'S HOUSE

An electrical fire in your home is frightening enough, but even more so when you depend upon a wheelchair for mobility. William and his sister are thankful that the fire was contained and the damage minimal. The problem remained.... the home wiring was very dangerous and there were no funds to make the extensive repairs.

When I met William, he told me of his sleepless nights, wondering if the wiring would cause another fire. One particular day he raised his head upward and asked God if there was anyone who could help. Within 20 minutes, a friend came to the door to tell him that NFI would be able to assist.

After our review, NFI has committed to a new electrical entrance, new wiring, smoke detectors, repair of the fire-damaged ceiling, and new roofing for William's home. We believe that God shows us the need and that we act in faith, knowing that He will provide the necessary resources. The corrective electrical work has begun and the other repairs will soon follow.
